

2025 School Charges and Voluntary Contributions

The School Education Regulations 2000 requires schools to notify parents of all contribution and charges prior to the start of the school year. These costs are divided into three areas: Voluntary Contributions, Personal Use Items, Charges and Other Optional Costs.

The Treeby Primary School Board has endorsed the following schedule of School Charges for 2025.

Voluntary Contributions

Financial support provided by parents plays a significant role in the provision of resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to students' learning experiences. The continued partnership between schools and parents is vital to ensuring that all students receive a level of education sufficient to carry them forward in today's society.

Contributions are voluntary; however, the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be maximised when families make a contribution to supplement funding gained from other sources, including the State and Federal governments. The total amount of voluntary contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay is the \$60 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000. At Treeby Primary School, the voluntary contributions will be used to purchase supplementary materials and resources used in classrooms as detailed below:
